## Plains American Indians

The Plains Indians lived in the area between the Mississippi 10 River and the Rocky Mountains. There were few trees but 20 lots of wildlife. One of the most important animals to the 31 Plains Indians was the buffalo. A few of the Plains tribes 42 include the Sioux, Cheyenne, and Comanche. The Plains Indians 51 followed the buffalo. They needed shelter that they could 60 move quickly, so they lived in teepees. A teepee was made 71 from leaning poles together and covering them with buffalo 80 hide. There were a few tribes that didn't move around, and 91 lived in grass lodges covered in mud. The Plains tribes were 101 hunters and gathers. Men usually wore animal skin leggings, a 111 loin cloth, and a belt. When it was cold, they wore buffalo 123 skin. Women and girls wore dresses made of deerskin. An 133 important ceremony was the Sun Dance. Another important 141 dance was the Ghost Dance that took place at night. The 152 Plains Tribes believed they could speak to the gods and their 163 ancestors during this ceremony. 167
