- Only post things that you would want everyone (in school, at home) to know. Ask yourself: Is this something I want everyone to see? This is like participating in table talk or raising your hand in your classroom.
- Use complete sentences.
- Be responsible for your own actions by using appropriate language and punctuation.
- Listen to other student's ideas or opinions on a topic and ask questions.
- Try to improve other student's ideas. Offer advice. Use accountability talk.
- Show respect to others online. Don't judge people by their ideas.
- Listen to others ideas and consider what they've said. Don't always think your idea is the best.
- Do not use your device to record (photo or video) others without their consent and your parent's consent.
- Understand that participating in classroom Discord is a privilege and not a right; if you choose not to follow the above expectations, you will lose the ability to type and speak in Discord. There are no second chances.
